## **President's Report** (Shelley Gerringer)

## **Admission Practices** (Kyle Johnson)

- Small Committee forming Additional AP experiences
- AP event/social in mid-December in KC (Trial/Test Run) Doing an event at Rockhurst High School on ethical dilemmas.
- Will have a session at conference and potentially Tools of the Trade
- AP in Action Auburn U Sep 15 Deadline; Too early deadline—should not be earlier than 10/15.
- It was suggested as a Lunch & Learn topic for an upcoming date.

#### **College Fairs** (Kristin Roop & Abby Klinckhardt-not present)

- Successful Fall fair season!
   18 RCFs and 66 non-RCFS (84 total)
- StriveScan usage
  - -Fall 2023 had 66.15% of sanctioned fairs scanning. {We are up 90% in scanning fairs!}
- Positive feedback from a variety institutions' reps (MO and non-MO) re: fall calendar
- Spring fair calendar set to release Dec. 2.
  - Confirmed STL RCF at Maryville on Sat., Apr. 12.
- Request to host a fair form will open in the new year. Will accept requests through spring conference. This will be for colleges who want to attend FALL fairs. First draft for FA25 will release in May.
- Future plans

- Continue to consolidate nearby fairs, create regional events where possible
   Continue to reduce the number of rogue fairs (was over 100 fairs a few years ago and now we are in the 60's)
- College fair bus grant {Blake, Emily S, etc.} 8 institutions/600 students bussed (mainly in NE MO area) to RCF's and utilized grant money to attend. HS were also awarded a one-year MOACAC membership to get access to more PD events. Hope to continue to offer this as an option in future years.
- Treasurers have cut reimbursement to 12/18 host sites. The college fair chairs will connect with the remaining 6 to get them to submit reimbursement forms by the end of 2024.
- StriveScan did not update cancellations/refunds and so it forced the use of paper registrations which is not ideal.

## **Communications** (Ebony Sistrunk)

- Continuous strong engagement with newsletters and updates
- Standalone email reminders about upcoming events has been effective
- Continuing to strengthen our social media presence, especially with the upcoming Spring Conference

#### Inclusion, Access and Success (Russell Brannen & Janiece Jones-not present)

- Braxton posting under review to be posted January 1, 2025. Will work with Scholarship Central to get this up and running.
  - We like the results the prompt from last year yielded, we'll stick with that format again if no issues which is to provide 3 essay choices, pick 2.
  - Need-based scholarship posting gets reviewed in the new year to be posted early next year.
- Creating survey to send to membership about reimagining events:
  - This will inform an event we either put together or attempt to partner with someone else (like MOCAN). For example, do we need topics on essays, etc.?
- Onboarding new committee members and recruiting co-chairs
- Asked what rural counselors need for them and their students. Suggested that they do
  regional presentations, etc. IAS could attend one of the associations' rural events (local) as
  well as present at MSCA in the fall.

school type so we can identify, for example, rural counselors so we can target mailings, etc.

#### **New Business**

Voting on bylaw change:

# Amendment to MOACAC Bylaws: Article V: Dues (Proposed Addition) Section 5: Unpaid Dues and Invoice Policy

- 1. Invoice Due Date: Invoices are due on the date of issuance or within 30 days of the event attended by the member, whichever comes first.
- 2. Payment Responsibility: Members are responsible for prompt payment of invoices regardless of the timing or receipt of reminder notifications.
- 3. Account Freezing and Event Registration Restriction: If an invoice remains unpaid 30 days after the due date, MOACAC reserves the right to freeze the member's account and restrict event registration as outlined below, regardless of the timing or receipt of reminder notifications:
  - Account Freezing: The member's account will be frozen, restricting access to MOACAC
    resources and benefits. Additionally, the accounts of all members employed by the same
    institution at the time of the unpaid invoice will also be frozen.
  - Event Registration Restriction: Members with outstanding overdue invoices will be prohibited from registering for or attending any MOACAC college fairs, professional development events, and other MOACAC-sponsored activities until all invoices are paid in full.
- 4. Reinstatement: Upon full payment of all outstanding invoices, member accounts and institutional registration privileges will be reinstated.
- 5. Reminder Notifications: While not required for enforcement of this policy, MOACAC may, at its discretion, send reminder notifications 7 days before the invoice due date and 30 days after the due date.

Effective Date: This amendment shall become effective upon approval by a majority vote of the MOACAC Executive Board on November 19, 2024

Executive Board voted on the above and bylaw change approved unanimously.
